BE AWARE OF WHAT YOU COMMUNICATE

Although all information texted to Choices Medical will be kept confidential, text messages on your phone have inherent privacy risks — especially when your cell phone is provided through your employer or when access to your phone is not password protected. Unencrypted text messages provide as much privacy as a postcard. You should not communicate any information with Choices Medical that you would not want to be included on a postcard that is sent through the Post Office.

Text Messages are sent at the touch of a button. Once sent, a text message cannot be recalled or cancelled. Errors in transmission, regardless of the sender's caution, can occur.

Neither you nor the person reading your text messages can see the facial expressions or gestures or hear the voice of the sender. Text messages can be misinterpreted.

It is the policy of Choices Medical that your text messages and any and all responses to them become part of your medical record.

IN AN EMERGENCY PLEASE CALL 911

Text communications are two-way communications. However, responses and replies to text messages sent to or received by either you or Choices Medical may be hours or days apart. This means that there could be a delay in receiving results or answers to questions that you may have regarding your condition. Therefore, if you have an urgent or an emergency situation, DO NOT contact, CALL 911.
